Our mission to uplift and support women and children has continued to guide us, enabling us to provide quality education, vocational training, family welfare, and cultural enrichment. The collective efforts of our institutions, partners, and community members have helped us achieve significant milestones, shaping brighter futures.

Key Achievements of the Year

Education

Nari Shiksha Niketan Post Graduate College (PG):

Enrolment of **677 students** (B.A. – 435, B.Sc. – 146, B.Com. – 21, M.A. – 75). Academic results were excellent with **100% pass rate in M.A.** and strong outcomes in UG courses. Faculty achieved national recognition with awards, publications, funded research projects, and patents. The college hosted numerous workshops, career counselling sessions, and cultural programs. NCC & NSS units actively promoted social awareness, while sports students represented Lucknow University at inter-university tournaments.

Nari Shiksha Niketan Inter College:

With **450 students and 35 teachers**, the school achieved **91.3% pass in High School** and **89.7% in Intermediate**. Founder's Week, science exhibitions, cultural activities, and Mission Shakti awareness campaigns enriched student life.

Mona Convent School:

Established in 1997, the school continues to deliver holistic education **with 421 students and 18 teachers**. With upgraded **STEM labs funded by Bajaj Auto Ltd.**, the school now provides advanced infrastructure including science labs, computer labs, CCTV safety, and modern classrooms. Vibrant cultural celebrations, sports, eco-drives, health camps, and teacher training programs fostered well-rounded student development.

Mona Chandravati Bal Shiksha Niketan:

With **195 students**, the school catered to underprivileged children through regular classes, examinations, and co-curricular activities. Students participated in yoga, health awareness drives, Independence Day rallies, and cultural festivals. The result was **100% pass** in final exams.

Skill Development

Nari Kala Mandir Training Centre:

Offered tailoring & allied craft diploma courses with **51 enrolments** and a **100% pass rate** in 2024-25.

Project Unnati (CSR by Bajaj Auto Ltd):

Entered its third phase (2024–2026), aiming to train **1000+ women annually**. In 2024-25, **1097 women** were trained in demand-driven trades – Computer Training, Beauty Culture, Fashion Designing, and Embroidery. **144 students were placed in jobs** while **953 became self-employed**. Spoken English, soft skills, financial inclusion workshops, and personality development classes enhanced employability.

Family Counselling Centre (FCC):

Cases Registered: 164 | **Closed:** 141 | **Compromised:** 65 | **Pending:** 146

Telephonic Counselling: 2140 | **Legal Help:** 62 cases | **Police Protection:** 150

The centres organized mohalla meetings, awareness campaigns, and follow-ups, making a strong impact on family welfare.

Natya Kala Kendra:

Our iconic auditorium with **1000 seating capacity** hosted conferences, cultural programs, seminars, and educational events. It continues to serve as a cultural hub for Lucknow.

1. Nari Shiksha Niketan Post Graduate College Annual Report 2024-25

Nari Shiksha Niketan PG College is government-aided and NAAC accredited College with the University of Lucknow. The college believes in imparting holistic education to students enrolled in Arts, Science, and Commerce, following the carricullaum as per the University guidelines. The Faculty of Arts offers 14 subjects and a Post-Graduate course, M.A. in Hindi, while 4 subjects are offered in the Science faculty. These are all regular courses. The Commerce faculty and B.A. in Psychology are self-financing courses. A total of 677 students were enrolled in various courses at the college for the Academic session 2024-25.

Admissions & Examination Results

In accordance with the norms prescribed by the University, the admission criteria were specified, and the process of admission to the first semester courses of B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., and M.A. was initiated in April 2024. The total number of students enrolled was as follows:

Committees of the College

1. Nari Kala Mandir Training Centre, Lucknow

The Nari Kala Mandir Training Centre has been offering one-year and two-year duration Tailoring and Allied Craft courses funded by the Directorate of Social Welfare, U.P., for several years. Certificates and diplomas are awarded upon successful completion of the course. This year, the enrolment was 51. Last year, 31 girls appeared for the examination, and the result was a 100% pass rate.

2. Project Unnati, Nari Kala Mandir Lucknow

Nari Sewa Samiti has been running the Skill Development Program, sponsored by Bajaj Auto Ltd, since 2015. This initiative aims to empower women through an employment-linked skill development program for sustainable livelihood.

The Unnati Project's third phase commenced on October 10th, generously supported by Bajaj Auto Limited. This phase is scheduled to extend until September 30th, 2026, aiming to provide training for over 1000 women/girls annually.

Under this phase during the year we have trained 1097 students in demand-driven trades, including Computer Training, Beauty Culture, Fashion Designing, and Hand Embroidery. We also introduced classes for Spoken English in this phase. We successfully secured placements for more than 144 students and supported 953 candidates who are now self-employed and comfortably sustaining their lives. Trade wise enrolment status is under-

For women welfare Nari Sewa Samiti runs Family Counselling Centre specialize in addressing family disputes, offering counselling, legal assistance, police protection, and psychological support for issues related to domestic exploitation, marital adjustments, abuse, domestic violence, dowry conflicts, widows' concerns, property disputes, and more. The centres also provide referral services such as short stay homes, free legal aid, and psychiatric treatment when needed.

Confidentiality is a top priority, with all registered cases handled discreetly and resolved at no cost. Operating with a three-dimensional approach — preventative, curative, and referral — the centres are steadfast in their mission to fortify family life and protect the interests of women.

| 03-09-1936 | - Nari Sewa Samiti was established on the initiative of Padmashri Smt. Mona Chandravati Gupta who founded the institution. It was started as an adult literacy campaign amongst women at the Zanana Park, Aminabad, Lucknow and was known as Ladies Zanana Park League, UP. It also held open air literacy classes for children in that area. |
| 1938 | - The ladies Zanana Park League was renamed Women's Social Service League. The foundation stone for its first building on Raja Nawab Ali Road was laid on 16.03.1938 by Lady Haig, wife of the then U.P. Governor. Finally in 1950 it was renamed Nari Sewa Samiti. |
| 1943 | - Nari Kala Mandir Production Centre was started at Chhedi Lal Dharmashala, Aminabad, later shifted to Akbarpur House and then to Charbagh and finally from there it moved into its own Building constructed in 1959 by the Samiti on the Old Kanpur Road, Lucknow. Dr. B.N. Vyas, one of the founder Member donated Rs. 6000/- to start a Kinder Garden School. This institution has now blossomed into a full-fledged school known as Mona Chandravati Bal Shiksha Niketan. |
| July 1945 | - Women's Academy was started for Intermediate classes. This has blossomed into an Intermediate and Post Graduate College education to over 3,500 students. This is now known as Nari Shiksha Niketan and has its own spacious building. |
| 1952 | - Nari Kala Mandir Training Centre was started. It has two courses for training: Two Year's Certificate Courses in Tailoring, Embroidery, Toy Making & Leather work etc. Special courses of three months for specialization in any one of the Certificate Courses mentioned above. |
| 1961 | - The Samiti has been doing Rural up lift work from its very inception. In addition to the work, which was being done by the Samiti in its original capacity, it started running Balbadis and Mahila Mandal Centres funded by the U.P. State Social Welfare Advisory Board. |
| 1962 | - Natya Kala Kendra, which is the biggest Auditorium in |

Northern India with seating capacity above 1000, was started on a plot of land donated by Late Sri H.S. Gupta, Bar-at-Law, Co-founder of Nari Sewa Samiti. Padmashri Smt. Mona Chandravati Gupta, his wife also donated Rs.20,000/- .At the same time a grant of Rs. 44,200/- was received from the U.P. Government. A further sum of Rs. 42,844/- was collected from donation and with all these funds, the Auditorium was built. Since then some more generous funds have flowed in from the Central and State Governments and the Auditorium now has 762 seats, efficient acoustics, stage lights and other gadgets necessary for a modern stage. Efforts are being made to provide more seats and air-cooling.
